Members of the U. S. Army, Navy, and Air Force Reserves will be providing FREE Medical Services to the Public 2 years of age or older June 16-June 25, 2015 at the Tuskegee Institute Middle School (TIMS).

Representatives from the Team met with the Tuskegee Council on April 23, 2015 to provide an overview of the Free Services to be provided.

Services to be provided at NO COST include:

- 1.) Medical Screening and non-emergency medical treatment.
- 2.) Sports Physicals.
- 3.) Dental Exam, extractions and fillings ONLY ( No Crowns or Root Canals).
- 4.) Optometry Exams and Free glasses (Single vision, 1 pair only).
- 5.) No emergencies, No OB Exams or OB Treatment.

These services will be available to anyone 2 years of age or older living in Tuskegee or surrounding community from 8:00AM until 5:00PM Daily including Saturdays and Sundays.

Tuskegee Institute Middle School (TIMS) is located at 1809 Franklin Road. The City is working to provide transportation to and from TIMS from a Downtown location. Details will be announced when finalized.
