Students are expected to be in school uniform everyday unless otherwise indicated by the school administration. Dress and appearance must not cause a disruption or present health or safety problems. Clothing that is distracting and/or revealing can be a disruption to the learning environment and is therefore not allowed. Hats, hoodies, and other types of head covering and sunglasses are not to be worn in school buildings, except for medical or safety reasons. **Uniforms may be purchased at the following retail locations: Dollar General, Maxway, Bargain Town, Wal-Mart, Dillard's, JCPenney, Sears, Kid's Corner, and many other stores.**

## Uniform Dress For Girls

**Skirt/Skorts:** Solid khaki/black cloth material skirts and/or skorts are permitted. They must be no more than 2" above the knee.

**Shorts/Slacks:** Solid khaki/black cloth material shorts and/or slacks are permitted. Shorts must be no more than 2" above the back knee. (Note: No baggy, no sagging,

**Shirts:** Solid red or gold three buttons golf/polo type shirts with collars. All shirts must be tucked in, no exceptions.

**Shoes:** Athletic shoes are preferred (no baby dolls/ ballerina, flip flops, or slides). **\*Only one pair of matching socks is to be worn at a time. (The administration will determine when boots can be worn).**

**Belts:** Belts are required with pants having belt loops. (Note: Students who arrive without belts, parent(s) will be contacted).

**Jewelry:** Hoop earrings are permitted but they must be no bigger than 1" in diameter. No dangling necklaces or bracelets. No colored wrist bands with/ without logos. (Unless authorized by administration)

**Hair:** Hair must be of natural color. No radical haircuts or hairstyles are permitted (Examples: Mohawks, flashy hair color, pictures or words cut into hair, only one part cut in hair).

## Uniform Dress For Boys

**Shorts/Slacks:** Solid khaki/black cloth material shorts and/or slacks are permitted. Shorts must be no more than 2" above the knee. (Note: No baggy, no sagging)

**Shirts:** Solid red or gold three buttons golf/polo type shirts with collars. All shirts must be tucked in, no exceptions.

**Shoes:** Athletic shoes must be worn (no flip flops, or slides). **\*Only one pair of matching socks is to be worn at a time. (The administration will determine when boots can be worn).**

**Belts:** Belts are required with pants having belt loops. (Note: Students who arrive without belts, parent(s) will be contacted).

**Jewelry:** No earrings permitted. No dangling necklaces or bracelets. No colored wrist bands with/without logos. (Unless authorized by administration)

**Hair:** Hair must be of natural color. No radical haircuts or hairstyles are permitted (Examples: Mohawks,, flashy hair color, pictures or words cut into hair, only one part cut in hair ).

\*All pants **MUST** be pulled up around the waist with a belt. Rubber bands around the leg of pants and pants tucked inside of shoes or boots are not a part of the uniform and are not acceptable. **Sagging pants ARE NOT ALLOWED!!!!**

Parents will be contacted to pick up students if they are not adhering to the dress code.

Note: Administrations reserves the right to determine the suitability of styles and accessories.
