**Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program  
(SFMNP)**



The Alabama Farmers Market Authority has provided a grant to the Area Agency on Aging to make available coupon booklets for seniors to buy locally grown fruits, vegetables and herbs. The requirements for the vouchers are:

1. Must be 60 years of age or older the day of application.
2. Must be a resident of Macon County or the State of Alabama.
3. Recipients' gross household monthly income must not exceed the following limits:
